ARC Voting/Board Quals Bylaws Amendment -- October 2018

<u>Note</u>: A "member of ARC" and a "member in good standing" is already defined in the ARC bylaws which may be found at https://www.augustarowingclub.org/documents-and-forms

VOTING RULES

- 1. In order for a member of ARC to be eligible to vote they must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Be a member in good standing
 - b. Participated in ARC programs for six calendar months
 - c. Participated (rowed, volunteered, refereed, etc) in two regattas as a member of ARC.
- 2. All qualified members are allowed one vote for all club wide meeting decision/elections.
 An adult member that is part of a committee is allowed one vote for all committee issues.
 An adult member elected to a voting position on the ARC Board is allowed one vote for all ARC Board issues. Members must be present to vote.

REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME A BOARD MEMBER

- 1. Any ARC member wishing to hold a non-executive ARC Board position must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Be a member in good standing
 - b. 18 years old
 - c. One calendar year as a member of ARC
 - d. Participated in two club sanctioned events. (I.E. LTR, NLTRD, SE Regionals/HOTS,etc)
- 2. Any ARC member wishing to hold an executive ARC Board position (President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, Jr. Program Representative) must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Be a member in good standing

- b. 25 years old
- c. Held a non-executive ARC Board position
- d. The Jr. Program Representative is exempt from part c, but their child must have participated in 2 seasons with the ARC Junior program. The seasons may be non-consecutive but must be within 12 calendar months of each other.
